The Stolatis Group to create performing arts ctr.

OSSINING, N.Y. - The Stolatis Group promoted its proposal for a performing arts center to be located in the center of the downtown area. More than 300 residents and visitors from the surrounding communities signed a statement of support for the center. The Stolatis Group has already presented this proposal to the Village Trustees who responded positively, and encouraged the further development of details related to the execution of this proposal.

The Stolatis Grp. proposal is to create an aesthetically compatible four-story facility in a lot that has been vacant for almost nine years. A "destination" restaurant would be located on the first floor, with art galleries and related retail on the second floor. Three live performance theatres would be located on the third and fourth floors. The fourth floor would also contain a complete state of the art conference facility, suitable for use by businesses and community groups.
